

MINUTES OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES: April 15, 2025
CLEAR LAKE SANITARY DISTRICT, CERRO GORDO COUNTY, IOWA

The regular board meeting was called to order by President Bale immediately following the public hearing at 5:30 p.m. Bale indicated to those present that the meeting was being tape recorded for meeting minute generation purposes.

Item #1. Opportunity for public to speak. No public present.

Item #2. Consent Agenda:

- Approve March 2025 Financial Statement.
- Approve March 2025 Invoices.
- Approve March 18th and March 24th, 2025 Board Meeting Minutes.

Motion by Nelson, second by Peterson to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting 'aye'.

Item #3. \$1,470,000 General Obligation Capital Loan Notes, Series 2025A.

- Resolution 25-08, A Resolution Appointing Paying Agent, Note Registrar, and Transfer Agent, Approving the Paying Agent and Note Registrar and Transfer Agent Agreement and Authorizing the Execution of the Agreement. Motion by Adams, second by Peterson to approve Resolution 25-08. President Bale called the roll with the following results: Peterson, 'aye'; Adams, 'aye'; Wolfram, 'aye'; Nelson, 'aye'; and Bale, 'aye'. Motion carried.
- Resolution 25-09, A Resolution Amending Resolution approving and authorizing a form of Loan Agreement and authorizing and providing for the issuance, and levying a tax to pay the Notes; Approval of the Tax Exemption Certificate and Continuing Disclosure Certificate. Motion by Nelson, second by Wolfram to approve Resolution 25-09. President Bale called the roll with the following results: Peterson, 'aye'; Nelson, 'aye'; Wolfram, 'aye'; Adams, 'aye'; and Bale, 'aye'. Motion carried.

Item #4. Infrastructure Upgrade Project – Pay Request #25 \$286,520.24. Motion by Peterson, second by Adams to approve Pay Request #25 in the amount of \$286,520.24 to John T Jones Construction. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting 'aye'.

Item #5. Lift Station #2 Landscaping Project – Pay Request #2 \$81,546.81. Motion by Adams, second by Nelson to approve Pay Request #2 in the amount of \$81,546.81 to Countryside Builders. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting 'aye'.

Item #6. EFIS Repair Project – Pay Request #1 \$4,037.50. Motion by Peterson, second by Wolfram to approve Pay Request #1 in the amount of \$4,037.50 to Countryside Builders. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting ‘aye’.

Item #7. Alliant Tertiary Project Pay Request:

- In Control #2 - \$62,366.50.

Motion by Nelson, second by Adams to approve the Alliant Tertiary Project Pay Request as per the amount listed. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting ‘aye’.

Item #8. Popp Excavating – Maintenance Building Sewer Quote \$22,000.00. Bale noted that this was approved via email and needed to be approved formally. Motion by Wolfram, second by Adams to approve the quote from Popp Excavating in the amount of \$22,000.00. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting ‘aye’.

Item #9. Resolution 25-10, A Resolution Approving a Construction Base Rate Credit for Apartment Complexes. The Board discussed a 50% base rate credit from the connect date until a certificate of occupancy is received. Wolfram recommended 70%, meaning the complex would be billed for roughly 30 base rates as opposed to 98 while construction is ongoing. Motion by Wolfram, second by Adams to approve Resolution 25-10 and changing the credit from 50% to 70%. President Bale called the roll with the following results: Wolfram, ‘aye’; Adams, ‘aye’; Peterson, ‘aye’; Nelson, ‘aye’; and Bale, ‘aye’. Motion carried.

Item #10. Alliant Energy Easement Proposal. Hanson presented the Board with a drawing of the route for the new power lines for the Tertiary Building, showing the lines hugging the District’s property line for much of the route. This will update and upgrade the existing line, as well as provide redundant power to the Tertiary Building, while staying out of the way should the need arises for future expansions. Motion by Peterson, second by Adams to approve the proposed route. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting ‘aye’.

Item #11. Account Adjustment - #007474-001. Moore explained that an outside hose spigot was left on and the customer was requesting a credit as the water did not go down the sewer. Based on recent averages the credit would amount to \$125.05. Motion by Nelson, second by Adams to approve the credit in the amount of \$125.05 for account #007474-001. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting ‘aye’.

Item #12. SBR Mixer Quote – Aqua Aerobics \$41,137.85. Hanson noted that this was in the budget as the District plans on replacing all four mixers over the next four years. Motion by Nelson, second by Wolfram to approve the quote from Aqua Aerobics in the amount of \$41,137.85. Motion carried, all Trustees present voting ‘aye’.

Item #13. Unfinished Business. No unfinished business to be discussed.

Item #14. Administrator’s Report. Hanson received a rough estimate on the repair of the old shop for the walls, doors, roof, openers and vents in the amount of \$195,000.

Item #11. Trustee’s Report. Bale mentioned the need for a public hearing next meeting for the amendment to Ordinance No. 7 for a rate increase.

There being no further business to discuss, motion by Nelson, second by Adams to adjourn. Motion carried, all trustees present voting ‘aye’. Meeting adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
